## Q&A

1. Where can I find the names of the local coordinators in my geography?

On the Colas Team Cup website, you can find the names of the local coordinators of your geography.

Go to the "Local coordinators" tab, click on your geography to find your coordinators' names.

2. Where can I find my Colas Identification number mandatory for the registration of the competition?

The personnel number is the number that identifies you to the Colas Group. You can find it on your salary form.

3. Does winning a soccer tournament mean that you are automatically qualified for the finals?

Qualification for the finals is based on three criteria: performance, fan support and activity on the Instagram social network.

This means you can win your tournament but not qualify for the finals, because another team will have accumulated more points on all these criteria.

For a breakdown of the points awarded for performance, fan support and activity on the Instagram social network, visit the CTC charter available on the competition's dedicated website.

4. Is it possible to register a 5-a-side soccer team that is not complete?

To enter the Colas Team Cup 5-a-side soccer competition, you must have a minimum of 5 players. Registration is impossible if the team is not fully completed.

5. Is there compulsory gear or clothing to wear during the local qualifying rounds?

No, but we do recommend that you wear clothing suitable for soccer or running.

6. Is the Colas Team Cup open to people from outside the Colas Group?

No. The Colas Team Cup is strictly open to Colas' employees on permanent, long-term contracts or apprenticeships provided that they are still in position by March 2026. (excluding fixed-term contracts, internships and temporary contracts).
